

English Soccer Experience 2020 Rules for Campers

Please make sure that you share these rules with your son/daughter.

They must bring these rules with them to camp. We expect that all players follow them closely or risk the consequences.

- Cell phones and/or text messaging instruments are allowed but are restricted. Players are allowed to carry them for emergency purposes and to make an evening phone call home. Phones are not allowed to be turned on during the day.
- All players must listen carefully to and follow instructions from all ESE staff both coaches and counselors.
- Be respectful, kind and courteous towards all of the other participants at camp at all times.
- Make sure you are familiar with the schedule and know where to be at all times.
- Players will be reminded of meeting times and places on a daily basis. Any schedule changes will be communicated with the players.
- Players will be told where they are allowed to be at all times. Under no circumstances are players allowed to wander around campus or be in areas they are not supposed to be.
- When walking to the cafeteria everyone must walk as a group.
- When leaving the cafeteria everyone must wait to be escorted by a coach or a counselor
- In the cafeteria players must clean up after themselves. If they don't they will be taken back to the cafeteria to do so.
- When dealing with cafeteria staff and any and all NAU staff we expect the players to be courteous and respectful.
- Be responsible for all of your own equipment both in the dorms and on the field.
- Do not use anyone else's equipment without permission.
- Do not go in to anyone's room without permission.
- All players will be held accountable for any damage caused in their rooms.
- Lost room keys will incur a charge.
- No cleats in the dorms or cafeteria.

- No bouncing balls in the dorms.
- Curfew must be strictly adhered to.
- No boys are allowed on the girl's floor and vice versa. ESE campers are not allowed on any other floors in the dorm other than their own (other groups will be using the dorms in addition to us)
- Ultimately, we are guests of NAU and we have to abide by their rules and regulations at all times.
